

# Call for Mentors

## Internship Cohort

### Are you an *All of Us* researcher? Do you want to train the next generation of researchers?

RTI International is seeking mentors for the *All of Us* Researcher Academy internship cohort. Your experience using the [All of Us Researcher Workbench](#) can provide valuable guidance to graduate and undergraduate students learning to access and analyze data from the [All of Us Research Program](#).

#### How It Works

Mentors help interns gain **hands-on research experience** with the *All of Us* dataset. They guide interns in completing a research project and submitting an abstract to the *All of Us* Research Program Researchers Convention or other scientific meeting.

Mentors will agree to a **3-month mentoring commitment** and will meet individually with their intern for at least 1 hour a week. Interns are expected to conduct project-related work for up to 20 hours a week.

Internships can be conducted **in person, virtually, or in a hybrid** format.



#### Mentor Characteristics

We are looking for mentors who have the following experience and qualifications:

- A doctorate-level degree (e.g., PhD, MD, or EdD)
- One or more active projects in the *All of Us* Researcher Workbench
- A passion for training student researchers and helping them learn about conducting research with the *All of Us* dataset
- Experience mentoring students from [communities historically underrepresented in the biomedical research workforce](#)
- Availability to mentor starting in May 2023

Mentors will receive a **\$3,000 stipend** in appreciation for their time and commitment.



#### Mentor-Intern Pairing Process

Mentors who apply and are accepted will be eligible to be paired with interns. Interns select eligible mentors from the *All of Us* Researcher Academy mentor database. Interns are matched to mentors with whom they share research interests or have expressed a preference.

The [All of Us Researcher Academy](#) is a comprehensive program that provides training and technical assistance for researchers conducting research with the [All of Us Researcher Workbench](#), the cloud-based analytics platform where registered researchers can access participant data. The Academy also supports peer-to-peer learning and network-building among researchers and students from communities that are underrepresented in biomedical research.

The *All of Us* Researcher Academy encourages researchers to engage *All of Us* data to explore questions about health and wellbeing. Currently, *All of Us* Researcher Academy resources are free for students, faculty, and post-docs at Historically Black Colleges and Universities [i.e., institutions described in section 4(b) of Executive Order 14041, incorporating by reference the institutions listed in 34 C.F.R. 608.2].
