Background: Roles and Responsibilities

Facilitator

Milestone meetings, White Hat debriefs, assist with strategy development under facilitator

Problem Solver

Keeps team focused on requirements and schedule, checks compliance

Proposal
Manager

Creator

Proposal calendar, responsibility matrix, agendas, proposal folder, notes, and action items

Connector

Obtain resources (e.g., information, templates, personnel)



The Problem

- New proposal authors need resources to be successful.
- **Win Forward** has countless resources, but authors lack time to sort through them, so they go unused.

The Solution

Create a roadmap of resources

- To simplify the Win Forward site through a prioritized roadmap
- To ease the transition for new proposal authors



Proposal Author Win Forward Roadmap

Make sure you have done your research on the client – *What is the client's vision/mission? How does this relate to our win themes? What buzzwords can I find through intelligence gathering?*


