

***All of Us* Researcher Academy Internship Opportunity**

Overview

RTI International is seeking interns for the *All of Us* Researcher Academy Internship Program.

The *All of Us* Researcher Academy

The [All of Us Researcher Academy](#) is a comprehensive program that provides training and technical assistance for researchers conducting research with the [All of Us Researcher Workbench](#)—a cloud-based analytics platform where registered researchers can access participant data. The *All of Us* Researcher Academy is designed to promote equitable access to and use of the *All of Us* Researcher Workbench by researchers from diverse backgrounds.

Internship Description

The *All of Us* Researcher Academy Internship is an experiential learning opportunity that will provide mentored training to graduate and undergraduate students on accessing and analyzing data from the [All of Us Research Program](#). Interns will be paired with a team of mentors who have active projects using the Researcher Workbench and will train interns. Interns will identify a public health research question and discuss findings with their mentors weekly. The interns will also participate in monthly meetings with other interns, complete monthly progress reports, and attend in-person and virtual events.

Responsibilities

- Identify a research question to investigate using the *All of Us* Research Program dataset.
- Document research findings and discuss weekly with mentor
- Attend at least two virtual workshops or course offerings through the *All of Us* Researcher Academy
- Participate in monthly Academy Intern Connection group meetings
- Complete a monthly progress report to provide ongoing updates on their mentored research experience
- Submit an abstract for potential inclusion in a future *All of Us* Researchers Convention or other scientific meeting
- Conduct project-related work over the course of 4 months

Additional Information

This paid internship will take place from June 2024 to September 2024, with the possibility of an extension on an as-needed basis. The internship requires a commitment of 4 months. Work schedule is flexible based on intern and mentor team availability.

Stipend*

Undergraduate student \$5,000 | Graduate student \$6,500

*The stipend will be paid in three installments over the course of the internship.

Qualifications

Eligibility Requirements

- Currently enrolled as a full-time student in an undergraduate (junior or senior) or graduate program (master's or PhD) related to health and/or social science. (e.g., sociology, public health, human development, social work, biology)
- Ability to complete the internship virtually, hybrid, or in-person

Preferred Qualifications

- Basic knowledge of Microsoft Office (e.g., Word, Excel, Outlook)
- Motivated with a passion for health and human science and/or social science
- Interest in conducting research with large datasets
- Exceptional written and oral communication, time management, and analytical skills
- Detail-oriented and able to work independently and collaboratively as part of a team
- Access to a computer and high-speed internet
