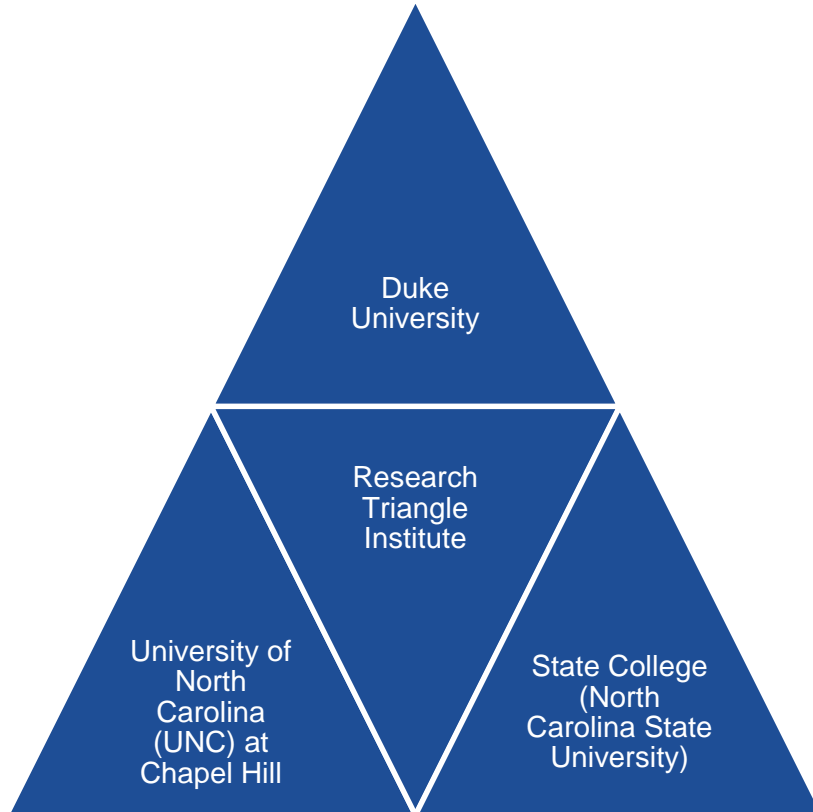

# RTI Presidents George Herbert and Thomas Wooten (1959–1998): RTI for and by the Triangle

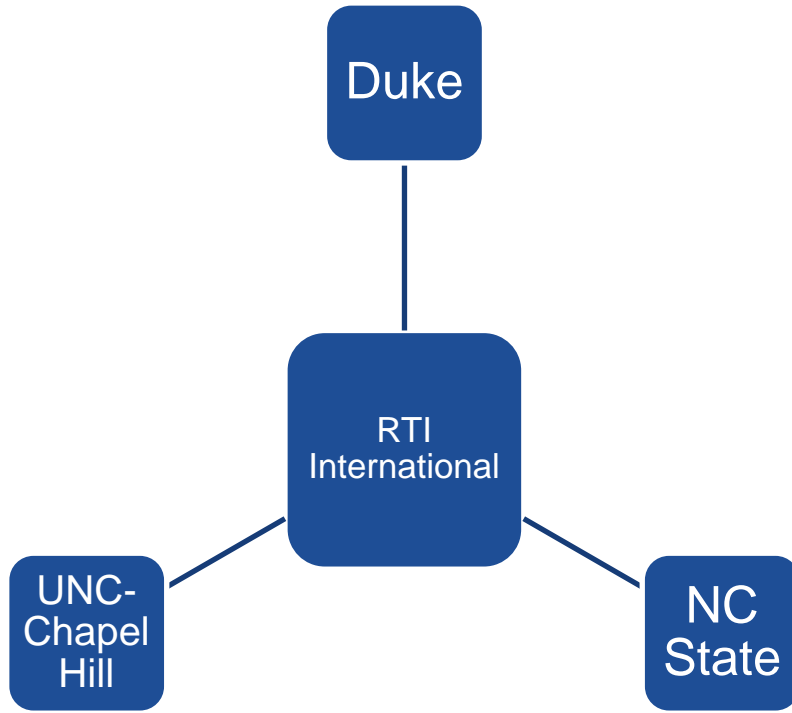


- Stem brain drain

What is the value and limitation of this model?



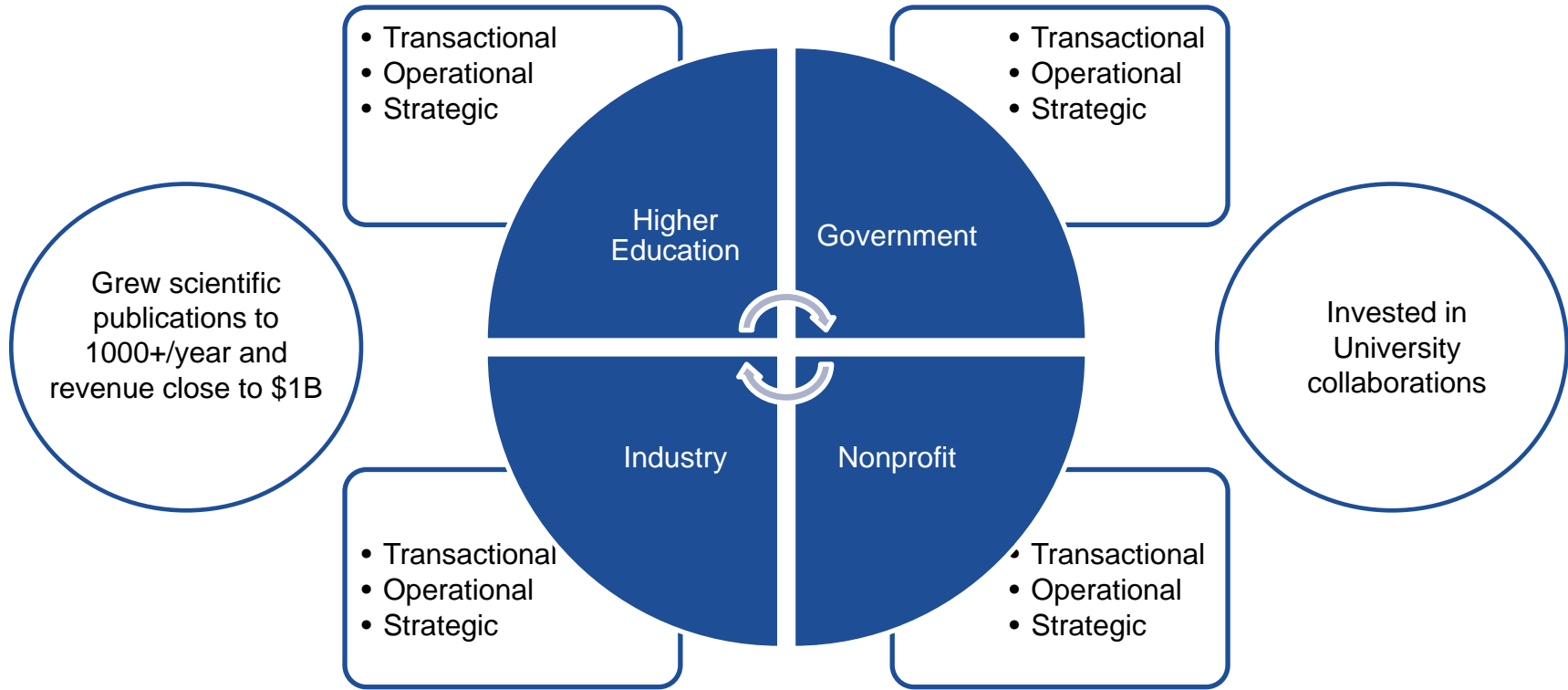
# RTI President Victoria Haynes (2000–2012): Growing Up and Away?
